


Spark Participation Pathways During Spark Redesign

Spark redesign began in 2023 and during this redesign process there are 2 different participation pathways that programs can choose.

- 1. Portfolio Path: Complete a portfolio to achieve a rating (must be listed with ERDC to do this).
- **2. QI Cycle Path:** Complete a 12-month Quality Improvement Cycle choose and work on a goal of choice. (Can be listed with ERDC or not).

Both options enable programs to:

- Participate in Spark and receive the Commitment to Quality (C2Q) designation.
- Receive Spark Support Funds (\$1,000 minimum).
- Have a framework to reflect on their program and make quality improvements.
- Receive incentive funds after achievement of rating or completion of QI Cycle. (\$ varies)





What's the difference?

Portfolio Path: Enables achievement of Star Rating. The Star Rating is a recognition of quality and allows programs to receive Spark-rated ERDC monthly incentive payment. (Which is why ERDC listing is required).

QI Cycle: Guides programs in quality improvement efforts by providing a framework for goal setting, resources, and coaching. The redesigned Spark system may include a goal setting cycle framework, participation will help identify issues and gather feedback before redesigned Spark is rolled out.

What about programs already in Spark?

- Star ratings will not be taken away if programs are not listed with ERDC.
- ERDC listing is required to submit a portfolio for the first time or for a higher rating.
- If a program's rating is expired, programs can complete a Spark Program Update Report (SPUR) to receive an updated certificate and information on completing a rating renewal. Program's do not need to be ERDC listed to renew. \$200 will be awarded after completion of a rating renewal.
- Programs that have already achieved a star-rating can choose to complete a 12-month QI cycle and will receive incentive funds after completion (*amount to be determined*).
